



## Technical Rider for BYU–Hawaii Shaka Steel and Street Band

2021 -2022

*The following information is provided to acquaint you with the technical requirements of these two ensembles that perform in tandem. Any questions regarding these or other matters should be address to Darren Duerden (duerden@byuh.edu) or Leilani Guerrero (leilani.guerrero@byuh.edu).*

<b>Load-in</b>	Approximately one-hour load-in and set up time is required.
<b>Performance Length</b>	The <i>Street Band</i> has an adaptable performance length up to 30 minutes. <i>Shaka Steel</i> (steel drum band) has an adaptable performance length between 30-60 minutes.
<b>Performance Type</b>	<p>The <i>Street Band</i> is a 6-10 piece brass-band style ensemble with the outdoor street music of New Orleans at its core.</p> <p><i>Shaka Steel</i> is a 12-16 member ensemble that performs the lively, fast paced music of the Caribbean and Latin America on steel pans, instruments native to Trinidad.</p>
<b>Performance Area Access</b>	Due to the amount of equipment to load in, close proximity to the stage is requested.
<b>Parking</b>	Nearby parking is required for the equipment vehicle.
<b>Performance Area</b>	A <b>minimum</b> performance area of 16' x 20' is requested. Of course, a larger stage would be more optimal.
<b>Lighting</b>	Sufficient lighting in order for 12-16 musicians and instruments to be well lit and visible to the audience.
<b>Piano</b>	None required
<b>Electrical Access</b>	Access within 50' (25' is better) of an electrical outlet. Two components utilize electricity: bass amplifier, PA speaker.
<b>Sound</b>	The <i>Street Band</i> can perform 100% without any amplification. <i>Shaka Steel</i> can also perform acoustically with the exception of the bass amp. If the venue is large and sound reinforcement is available however, 4-6 overhead mics (plus one for the drum-set bass drum), can greatly enhance the volume and musical presence.
<b>Dressing Rooms</b>	A room (or rooms) for 16 musicians to change clothes and warm up near the performance area is requested
